

YeNo Privacy Policy

1. Introduction

This Privacy Policy explains how YeNo (“YeNo”, “we”, “us”, or “our”) collects, uses, and protects information when you access or use our platform.

YeNo is built with a **privacy-first approach**, meaning we aim to minimize data collection and give users maximum control over their information.

2. Data We Collect

2.1 Information You Provide

We may collect:

2.2 Automatically Collected Data

We may collect limited technical data, such as:

- Device type and browser
- IP address (for security and fraud prevention)

2.3 Blockchain & Wallet Data

- Wallet addresses used to interact with YeNo
- Public blockchain transaction data

This data is **public by nature** and not created or controlled by YeNo.

3. What We Do NOT Collect

YeNo does NOT collect or store:

- Private keys
- Wallet passwords or seed phrases
- Sensitive financial credentials
- Unnecessary personal identification data

We do not require KYC for basic platform usage.

4. How We Use Data

We use collected data strictly to:

- Operate and maintain the platform
- Improve performance and user experience
- Enhance AI models and prediction suggestions
- Prevent fraud, abuse, and security threats
- Provide user support

We do NOT use personal data for intrusive tracking or profiling.

5. AI & Data Usage

We do NOT use aggressive tracking or invasive advertising cookies.
