- There is a balanced number of users on both sides (Yes/No)

If these conditions are not met, all funds are automatically refunded.

Demo Mode:

Demo predictions operate separately and do not involve real funds.

Payout Formula:

$\text{Payout} = (\text{Total Pool} - \text{Commission}) / \text{Number of Winners}$
